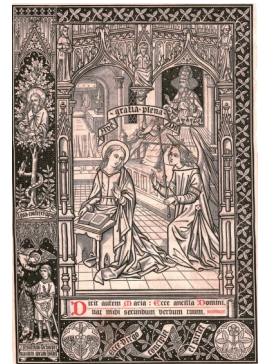

Pope Francis has designated the upcoming Liturgical Year (2015-2016) as an extraordinary jubilee focusing on God's mercy. Inspired by Jesus' declaration in John 10 that "I am the door" and "whoever enters through me will be saved, and will come in and go out and find pasture," it is thought that the custom of maintaining a Holy Door during a jubilee year goes back to Pope Sylvester (+335 A.D.). At the request of the Emperor Constantine, Pope Sylvester issued a bull proclaiming immunity from all punishment for Christians who entered the doors of the Lateran Basilica in Rome. In calling an extraordinary jubilee in 1983, St. John Paul II said that the believer's pilgrimage through a Holy Door "evokes the passage from sin to grace which every Christian is called to accomplish." Because some of the faithful are unable to make a pilgrimage to Rome for this extraordinary jubilee, Pope Francis has asked that each diocesan ordinary designate a Holy Door at their own cathedral and at other strategically located churches in their dioceses for the benefit of the faithful. Bishop Guglielmone will inaugurate a Holy Door at the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist in Charleston on 13 Dec. and, after consultation with each vicar forane, has designated the following churches and shrines as sites for pilgrimage in the Holy Year: Aiken: Old St. Mary Help of Christians Beaufort: St. Gregory the Great in Bluffton Charleston: Cathedral of St. John the Baptist Columbia: St. Peter Greenville: St. Mary Myrtle Beach: St. Michael in Murrells Inlet, St. Anthony in Florence, and the Shrine of Our Lady of South Carolina - Our Lady of Joyful Hope in Kingstree Rock Hill: The Oratory Chapel Each church will also maintain a holy door. Please encourage the members of your parish to celebrate the Year of Mercy by visiting one of the Holy Doors during this upcoming jubilee. Some have noticed that we now have a new logo and have asked what the pelican in the crest stands for. Here is your answer:

According to legend, in a time of famine a mother pelican would draw blood from her own chest and give the blood to her chicks. Thus the pelican symbol in Christianity, also called pelican-in-her-piety, symbolizes the sacrifice of Christ on the cross (because he gave his blood for others) as well as the Eucharist (because it represents Christ's blood and provides spiritual nourishment).
